### MONTHLY TRAINING PROGRAMS

Training programs may be designed for the needs of each horse and owner and their individual goals. Owners may have their horses trained in their absence or while they are present and participating. The trainers can work on dressage, jumping, lunging, ground work and trail riding. We value a well-rounded education that incorporates all of these skills. #### **Tack and Equipment**

Owners must provide a suitable and well-fitted saddle, girth and a bridle with a flash noseband attachment. We also appreciate the provision of clean saddle pads, grooming tools and protective boots for the horse.

#### **Payment and Scheduling**

Owners will pay for the monthly training program by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

If the owner would like to be present at the time of the training, they must schedule the training session in the lesson book located at the indoor arena and present the horse in tack to the trainer at the scheduled time.
